

Coach Lindsey Davis is returning to the Smallwood Marlins as Head Coach this summer after working as the Assistant Coach for two previous summers. She has been coaching all age groups and all ability levels since January 2009 after swimming competitively for fourteen years. She currently lives and works full time as an elementary school teacher in Alexandria, Virginia.

Coach Lindsey was born and raised in Bangor, Maine and swam locally for the Hurricane Swim Club and later on the prestigious Seacoast Swimming Association (former Olympian Jenny Thompson is an alumni). Coach Lindsey came to Southern Maryland after relocating from Connecticut, where she attended Central Connecticut State University and graduated with a Bachelor's Degree in Elementary Education in December 2008. She swam for four years on the Division 1 team at CCSU and was co-captain for two years. She was ranked in the top 100 of all Division 1 swimmers in the 200 backstroke and received many awards and recognition from the Northeast Conference during her collegiate career. Coach Lindsey has participated in several USA Swimming national-level meets, only missing the 2008 Olympic Trial cut in the 200 meter backstroke by one second.

Coach Lindsey brings her knowledge of stroke technique, racing strategy, and aerobic training to Smallwood after swimming for two nationally recognized coaches. She has participated in countless clinics and practices as a swimmer and a coach. She currently coaches for the Elite Rays Swim Club, a year-round USA Swimming club team. Coach Lindsey is looking forward to helping the Smallwood swimmers train hard, get in top physical condition, and have fun as a team.
